



Second Reading: The testimony to Christ was confirmed among you, so that you are not lacking in any spiritual gift as you wait for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor 1:6-7)

Gospel: "Watch, therefore; you do not know when the lord of the house is coming." (Mk 13:35)

- 4. Pray a decade of the Rosary before bed.
- 5. Read the opening chapters of the St. Luke's Gospel (the detailed account of Mary's fiat and the birth of Christ.)


