

JOIN US TO PRAY THE ROSARY


The rosary is prayed every morning at 8:40AM before the 9:00AM Mass and every Monday at 7:00PM in the church. Please join us!

Second Reading: We await new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. (1 Pt 1:13)




Gospel: John the Baptist appeared in the desert proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.(Mk 16:4)


