Please do not schedule the catering hall prior to making arrangements at the parish. Couples are required to attend the Pre-Cana Program of the Parish at least six months prior to the wedding.



Training for any student in grade 4-12 interested in becoming an altar server will begin in February. Please see the form in the back of the church if interested. Thank You!



So they went and saw where Jesus was staying, and they stayed with him that day. (Jn 1:39)


ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY




