Couples planning to be married at Saint Francis De Sales are asked to contact the Parish Office no less than eight months prior to the wedding date. Please do not schedule the catering hall prior to making arrangements at the parish. Couples are required to attend the Pre-Cana Program of the Parish at least six months prior to the wedding.





THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS


First Reading: I am filled with restlessness until the dawn. (Jb 7:4)

Good Luck to all of our SFDS Basketball teams with their upcoming playoff games!




SFDS FEAST DAY FELLOWSHIP
