

THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS



Gospel: He was among wild beasts, and the angels ministered to him. (Mk 1:13)





All applications are due by Friday, March 1st, 2024. In March, prospective families and students in Grades 2-8 will have an interview with the administration. For a Virtual Tour, please contact us at admin@stfrancisschoolbh.net. After the interview, applications will be reviewed, and families will be notified of their status by March 28th, following the priority for admission

If your child is accepted, a \$200 Registration Fee and one-month tuition will be required. Please note that all fees and tuition are non-refundable. If your child is placed on a waiting list due to space capacity, you'll be notified by Thursday, March 28th. To be considered for the priority of admission, submit your application by Friday, March 1st, 2024. Applications after March 1st are accepted only if space is available in that grade.

Dear Parishioners.

I am happy to provide another update on the Building our Legacy of Faith and Community Campaign.

To date we have raised \$2.86 million from over 450 families and gifts continue to be pledged. Thank you to everyone whose generous pledges of sacrifice have given us this incredible opportunity to renovate St. Francis de Sales parish.

When I last wrote, I mentioned we are working with Michael Mallia from DiProperzio & Mallia Architects. After many months of reviewing proposals and contracts with the Buildings and Grounds Committee, I am very excited to share the next phase of the campaign, the interior of the church.

We have hired Patrick Clark from Sunlites Stained Glass. Starting the month of February, scaffolding will be up for three weeks, as Patrick begins to restore the choir loft interior stained glass. Later in the Spring, as the weather gets warmer, he will work during the week to continue the cleaning, repair, and restoration of the stained glass windows and frames. Also, I am happy to let you know the windows will once again open for fresh air!

The exterior work of the church continues, repointing, waterproofing and cleaning of the brickwork. The new church doors will be installed this month and repair of the roof will begin in early Spring. In addition, we have new signage throughout our Parish property, including the Church, Rectory and Parish House.

Furthermore, we are in the process of finalizing the second phase of the interior of the church which includes: new lighting, upgrade of audio/visual equipment, restoration of the pews and decorative painting. I look forward to letting you know the timeline of the interior design projects.

While I said it above, I want to once again thank you for your generosity that has allowed us to undertake these projects and your patience as we execute them. If you were unable to participate last year, please kindly consider making a pledge that financially works for your family. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to connect with me after Mass or give me a call.
