Please do not schedule the catering hall prior to making arrangements at the parish. Couples are required to attend the Pre-Cana Program of the Parish at least six months prior to the wedding.




THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS

RECONCILIATION MONDAY

On Monday, March 25, 2024, our Diocese will join both the Archdiocese of New York and the Diocese of Rockville Centre in celebrating Reconciliation Monday. On this special day, all the parishes of our dioceses will offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation, from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM, in preparation for the holy days of the Paschal Triduum.

LENTEN REMINDER FROM THE BISHOP

The Most Reverend Robert Brennan wishes to draw attention to the following:

- Abstinence: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- Fasting: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals.
